

HOW TO INSTALL SKYPE FOR BUSINESS ON YOUR HOME PC.

Step 1: Click "[HERE](#)" to navigate to Skype download page.

** if prompted to trust web page, click accept.

Step 2: Click on the "Download Skype for Business" Icon



Step 3: Next, select "Download free basic client". Then scroll down and select English Language.





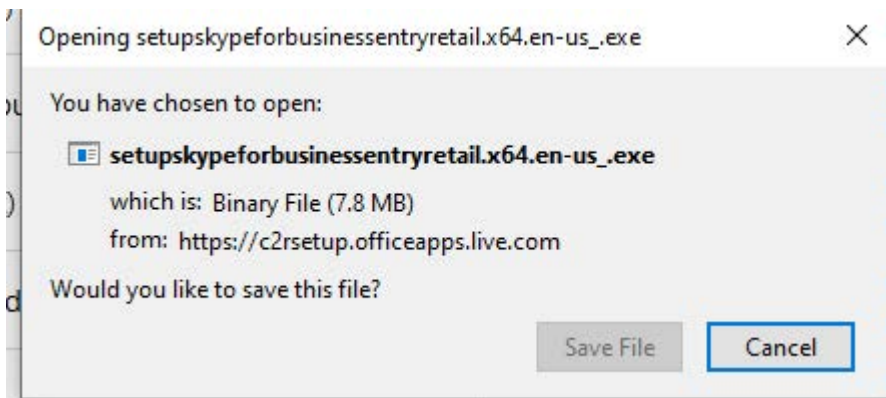

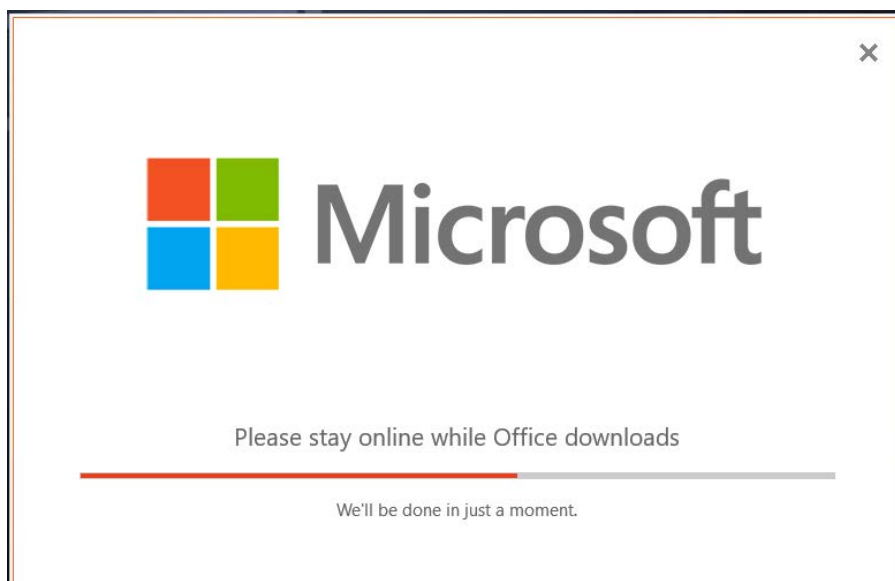
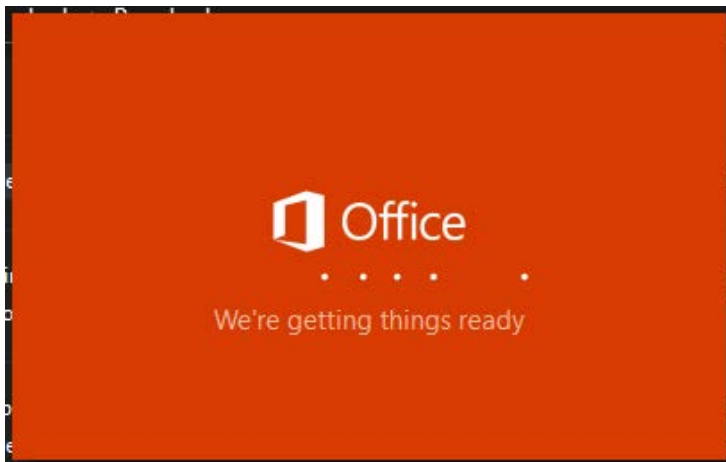
Step 4: Save the file to your computer. Default location may be the downloads folder.




Step 5: Once download, double click the downloaded file.
